WHEREAS the acceptance of the financial aid was carried out according to erroneous plans and specifications, therefore the financial aid is not enough to carry out the paving work on Rang 4 and on Leggatt road.

FILING OF A PAVL REQUEST - LEGGATT ROAD AND RANGE 4 - PAVING - PRELIMINARY ESTIMATE

WHEREAS the Town of Métis-sur-Mer has taken cognizance of the terms and conditions for the application of the Restoration and Acceleration component of the Local Road Assistance Program (LRAAP)

WHEREAS the interventions referred to in the request for financial assistance concerning local roads of level 1 and/or 2 and, where applicable, those aimed at the Restoration component are provided for in the five-year/three-year plan of intervention having obtained a favourable opinion from the Ministry of Transport

WHEREAS, only work completed after the date of the letter of advertisement is eligible for financial assistance;

WHEREAS the City of Métis-sur-Mer is committed to obtaining the necessary funding for the completion of the entire project, including the Ministry's share

WHEREAS the Town of Métis-sur-Mer chooses to establish the source of calculation of the financial assistance according to the following option:

The detailed estimate of the cost of the work;

WHEREAS the project manager of the municipality, Mr. William Page-Levesque, acts as the representative of the municipality with the Ministry in this file;

FOR THESE REASONS, on the proposal of Councillor Ms. Tracy Sim and unanimously resolved and adopted that the Council of the Town of Métis-sur-Mer authorizes the submission of an application for financial assistance for the eligible work, confirms its commitment to have the work carried out in accordance with the terms and conditions of application in force and recognizes that in the event of non-compliance with them, the financial assistance will be terminated.

7.3 Purchase of tires for the 10-wheel truck.

RESOLUTION #22-09-138 PURCHASE OF TIRES FOR THE 10-WHEEL TRUCK

The purpose of this request is to issue a construction permit for the replacement of the exterior siding and roofing of the building housing the foghorn.

CONSIDERING THAT the purpose of this project is to restore and enhance the existing heritage buildings in order to preserve the historical interest of the site;

CONSIDERING THAT the new exterior siding will be made of cedar shingles in the same color as the existing building;

CONSIDERING THAT the new roof siding will be lighthouse red sheet metal;

FOR THESE REASONS,

It is proposed by Councillor Ms. Tracy Sim and unanimously resolved that the Council of the Town of Métis-sur-Mer accepts the recommendations of the members of the Planning Advisory Committee and grants the request as presented in the documents submitted for the approval of a permit application.

8.2 Request for a building permit in the PIIA zone at 349 Cascade Street.

CONSTRUCTION PERMIT APPLICATION IN PIIA ZONE AT 349 CASCADE STREET

Request for a construction permit to replace the exterior siding of the main building in the PIIA zone.

CONSIDERING THAT, on the facades of the building visible from a public or private thoroughfare, the type of material, the layout, the texture and the colors used for the siding remain unchanged or are similar in appearance to those of typical buildings in the historical zones

CONSIDERING THAT the replacement of the component(s) does not alter the overall composition of the building, remove an element intrinsic to the architectural style of the building, or break with the uniformity of a single component

FOR THESE REASONS,

It is proposed by Councillor Mr. Raynald Banville and unanimously resolved that the Council of the Town of Métis-sur-Mer accepts the recommendations of the members of the Planning Advisory Committee and grants the request as presented in the documents submitted for the approval of a permit request in the PIIA zone.

8.3 Request for a building permit in the SPAIP zone at 333 Cascade Street.

CONSTRUCTION PERMIT APPLICATION IN PIIA ZONE AT 333 CASCADE STREET

Request for a building permit to extend the main building in the PIIA zone.

CONSIDERING THAT the building extension will not obstruct views of elements of heritage or landscape interest from the public thoroughfare

CONSIDERING THAT the shape, slope and materials of the roofs of the extension are similar to those of the original building;
