RESOLUTION #23-07-121 ROUSSEAU STREET REHABILITATION CONTRACT AWARDED

WHEREAS the Town has proceeded with the opening of tenders for the "Rousseau Street Rehabilitation" project;

WHEREAS four (3) contractors submitted a bid;

ATTENDU QUE la firme Tetra Tech QI Inc. a procédé à l'analyse des soumissions;

WHEREAS Tetra Tech QI Inc. recommends awarding the contract to "2646-1871 Québec Inc. Aménagement Benoit Leblond", being the contractor submitting the lowest compliant bid in the amount of \$311,733.55, taxes included;

IT IS THEREFORE PROPOSED by Councillor Alexandre Tanguay and unanimously resolved that the Council of the Town of Métis-sur-Mer award the contract to "2646-1871 Québec Inc. Aménagement Benoit Leblond" for the rehabilitation of rue Rousseau in the amount of \$311,733.55, taxes included. This work is eligible under the TECQ 2019-2024 program.

RESOLUTION #23-07-122 MANDATE A LABORATORY TO ANALYZE SOIL AND MATERIALS FOR THE ROUSSEAU STREET PROJECT
