



ANOTHER STEP FORWARD FOR THE LIGHTHOUSE

The final step in the acquisition process was finally taken last November when a long-term lease was signed between the Ville de Métis-sur-Mer and the Association des résidents de la pointe du phare (ARRP). This agreement, technically known as an emphyteutic lease, will allow the ARRP to operate the site for the next 15 years. The immediate focus will be to restore operational functionality of the buildings, which have had little or no maintenance over the past decades. The Ville has already started this urgent work by upgrading several elements of the electrical system, installing new septic systems and adding a ventilation system to the lighthouse tower. The ARRP will now focus on the keeper's house with



the hope that it will be ready to rent by this summer. It has also requested a large grant from Parks Canada for work on the lighthouse tower that is essential for its long-term structural integrity.

The Association is also developing a plan for public access. According to the agreement, visitors will have access to the site for at least 90 days during the summer season. Visitors arriving by car will, however, normally need to park at the head of the road and walk to the lighthouse site. This pleasant 1-km walk takes only 15 minutes and should add to the overall experience. A parking area for this purpose should be available by early summer.

So, after seven years of waiting, the ARRP can move forward with the Ville and its other partner, Heritage Lower St. Lawrence, towards the shared vision of preserving this community icon and making it accessible to the public while maintaining the tranquil environment and natural beauty of the point. This mission will require support from the community, and past efforts have raised over \$90,000 in donations and pledges. Now that work can begin in earnest, the association will begin collecting remaining pledges as well as undertake additional fundraising efforts in the new year. 

INFO-PRÉVENTION - Fire safety newsletter January 2019



Exit clearance

In case of fire, it is essential to be able to exit your home quickly. In winter, accumulation of snow or ice in exterior doorways can hinder evacuation.

- After each snowfall, remove snow from exits, balconies and patios.
- Also make sure to remove snow and ice from windows. A frozen window could prevent evacuation.
- Plan a meeting place that is accessible in winter that would be visible by firemen as soon as they arrive.

When a fire occurs, you and your family could have **less than three minutes** to get out safe and sound. Think of the precious seconds you would lose if the exit you needed to use was snowbound.

- Make sure that windows that could be used as emergency exits are accessible to young children from the inside, and that they know how to open them.
- Make an evacuation plan for your house and practise the plan with your family to increase your chances of getting out safe and sound in case of a fire.

Other things to think of...

- Make sure that your civic number is visible at all times from the street in order to facilitate emergency services.
- Inform your municipaliy if the fire-hydrant nearest your home is snow-covered.
- Make sure that the daycare where your child/children go has an emergency exit other than the main exit, and that all exits are cleared and snowplowed.
- If your parents live in their own home but are not completely autonomous, make sure they are aware of the risks of fire and that the safety exits of their house should always be cleared of snow.
