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PROGRAMME FAVORISANT L'UTILISATION DES COUCHES EN COTON

RÉSOLUTION NO. 22-03-38

Considérant la Politique familiale de la Ville de Métis-sur-Mer;

Considérant que la Ville de Métis-sur-Mer désire encourager l'utilisation des couches de coton, visant à réduire l'utilisation des couches jetables;

Pour ces motifs, il est proposé par madame Tracy Sim et unanimement résolu, que la Ville de Métis-sur-Mer instaure un Programme favorisant l'utilisation des couches de coton. Les parents qui résident sur le territoire de la Ville de Métis-sur-Mer et qui optent pour l'utilisation des couches en coton, recevront sur preuve d'achat jusqu'à 150. \$, représentant 50 % du coût d'achat.

REGULATION CONCERNING ANIMALS

In this regulation it is specified that:

- The owner cannot let dogs roam in a public place or private property other than that of the owner of the animal;
- Any owner of an animal, in a street or a park, must remove excrement and deposit them in a container or bag.

Act to promote the protection of persons by establishing a framework with regard to dogs.

In order to register your dog, you can print the form on the Town's web site or come at the municipal office. Fill it out and bring it to the office with your payment. At this moment, you can choose your medal. Thank you.

THE CLEANING OF THE CHIMNEYS of your property is a simple but an essential procedure. The accumulation of creosote inside the chimney represents a high risk of fire. In addition, a chimney fire can reach the interior walls and the roof of your house.

You can consult the list of the chimney cleaners accredited by the Association des professionnels du chauffage (APC), recognized by the Régie du Bâtiment du Québec, at the following address: www.poelesfoyers.ca.

It is no longer necessary to call the municipal office to check in, the municipality no longer keeps a reservation list. You must directly contact a chimney sweep of your choice to carry out the work.


An upcoming consultation of the regional English speaking community

THE GREEN NEWSLETTER

September 2022 « Coming soon near you! »

HELLO,

Always looking to improve its record on waste reduction, the Quebec government adopted 3 regulations this summer that will have an impact on our daily lives:

First, the modernization of the deposit system. This fall will mark the beginning of the transitional period leading to a deposit on all beverage containers from 100 ML to 2 liters as of November 1, 2023. Milk cartons, water bottles, wine bottles, juice bottles will then have a deposit of \$0.10 to \$1.00. They will have to be returned to the store or to an appropriate drop-off location rather than being disposed of in the blue bin. We will keep you informed of the deployment of this system on our territory when we have the details.

Secondly, the **modernization of selective collection** will aim to make the industry 100% responsible for the recovery of recyclable materials and it will be forced to reach recovery rates. Currently and by using a simplification, municipalities have one contract for the collection of the blue bin and another one for the processing of recyclable materials. The modernization will make the industry responsible for the processing and will

compensate the municipalities 100% for the collection of the blue bin. In the coming months, we will see how this modernization will be implemented in our area.

Finally, the modification of the Regulation respecting the recovery and reclamation of products by enterprises, which is called in the trade: vExtended Producer Responsibility (EPR). An EPR is an ecofee that the consumer pays with the purchase of certain products to ensure their recovery, for example: paint. batteries, electronic devices, etc. This amendment will add new products such as certain types of lead-acid batteries (January 2023), agricultural plastics (June 2023), pressurized fuel containers (June 2024), etc. As with the deposit, the important thing will be to have adequate drop-off points for these products in our region.
